## LOCATION

The rug camp is being held in the Main floor conference rooms of the non-smoking Ramada Inn, Ligonier, Pennsylvania - a picturesque town in the state's Laurel Mountains. The Inn is a short walking distance from "The Diamond," a beautiful historic park in the heart of town. The historic Town Hall is located on the Diamond, where our Rug Show will be on Wednesday, April 26. Ligonier offers numerous historical attractions, unique shops and local eateries that will charm your palate.

## SCHEDULE

Meet the teachers during the included Sunday evening dinner and visit with friends old and new. Classrooms will open Sunday, April 23rd in the evening. Classes will be held from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm Monday through Wednesday, April 24th - 26th, and from 9:00 am until 12:00 noon Thursday April 27th. Hooking rooms will be open until late in the evening.


